

# LED Street Lighting Workshop

ML&P and Chugach Electric are currently replacing the HPS street lamps with LED's. While the LED's provide a huge energy savings to the city, grievances from Anchorage citizens and area Community Councils have been brought forward. Citizens for Responsible Development (CRD) has partnered with other organizations to address this issue by holding an afternoon workshop on April 20, 2017 with Nancy Clanton, President of Clanton & Associates. Nancy speaks throughout the nation on topics relating to sustainable design, energy efficiency and light pollution. She is one of the nation's leading research and design engineers for street lighting.

This workshop will be open to the public and is geared toward bringing all stakeholders to the table: ML&P, Chugach Electric, Anchorage Police Department, Anchorage Fire Department, the Mayor's office, Assembly members, Community Council representatives, municipal planners, traffic planners and local development project developers.

With all stakeholders on the same page and working together we believe that Anchorage can have some of the most energy efficient street lighting while maintaining the necessary illumination for safety, and still watch the aurora borealis from inside the city.
