# RUBA Program: in brief

Rural Utility Business Advisors Program (RUBA)

- Created due to a 1996 amendment to the Safe Drinking Water Act: new water/wastewater utilities must be viable and have sufficient technical, managerial, and financial capacity.
- EPA-funded with State of Alaska match.
- Goal: to increase the managerial and financial capacity of rural water and wastewater utility providers across Alaska by providing advice, assistance, and training.

## Capacity includes:

- Operational capacity
- Management capacity
- Financial capacity

## Support includes:

- Onsite training & assistance
- Remote training & assistance
- Operations and Maintenance Best Practice Scoring
- QuickBooks Helpline
- 32-hour classes, online or in-person
- & more!



## RUBA Successes & Lessons: in brief

Has it increased managerial and financial capacity? What do the numbers say?

- Correlation between BP scores and sustainable utilities.
- Correlation between community engagement with their RUBA staff & improved BP score.
- Correlation between attending a weeklong course & improved BP score.
- Correlation between RUBA staff travel to a community & improved BP score.

## Challenges to Success:

- Need someone on the ground to work with.
  - Turnover in communities.
  - Vacancies in communities.
- Lack of sufficient revenue to do the basics / even get started.






# What's going on with rural Bulk Fuel?

- \$1.5 billion minimum needed to repair, rebuild, relocate bulk fuel tanks
- Deferred maintenance unfunded
- Lack of infrastructure replacement funding
- **Lack of training**
- Lack of coordination

# Past Bulk Fuel Training Initiatives: 2004 DCRA/Denali Partnership

DCRA & Denali Commission partnered in 2004 to create a bulk fuel managers training for the Denali Training Fund.



# 2016-2019 DCRA/Denali Partnership

## DCRA & Denali Commission partnered in 2016-2019:

- Created two 2-day training workshops for bulk fuel managers.
- Created a Best Practices scoring analysis tool.



## DCRA & Denali Commission 2016-2019 partnership

Training workshops for bulk fuel managers, 2 days each:

## **Bulk Fuel Financial Management:**

- Offered in February 2019 in Anchorage
- 17 attendees both

## Bulk Fuel Management for Electric Utilities:

- Offered in March 2019 in Anchorage
- 24 attendees

# DCRA & Denali Commission 2016-2019 partnership

## Recommendations from the report:

- Use the assessment tool in grant funding decisions.
- Add more operator training.
- Conduct the administrative training regularly.
- Create workable business plans.
- Create sustainable rate setting tools.

#### Additional recommendations:

- Emphasize that bulk fuel is an everything problem.
- Find more ways to tie it in with other work that supporting & partnering agencies are doing in rural Alaska.
- Emphasis on creating and maintaining R&R accounts.



## DCRA & Denali Commission 2025-2029 partnership

Denali Commission seeks to carry out one recommendation from the report, and contracts DCRA to do so:

Conduct the administrative training regularly.

- Updating the training manual etc.
- Providing bulk fuel administrative training
  - 3-day training
  - 4 times/year
  - Reimbursable travel grants
